3. Nomination and application deadlines

Full academic year and first semester	From March 1st to June 15th
Second semester	From September 1st to November 30th

Nomination procedure : Students must be nominated by the home university by email. The nomination has to include : full name, date of birth, email address, field and period of study. Once nominated, students have to fill in a « Dossier de candidature Erasmus » (Erasmus application form) which are available on our website : <https://pharmacie.edu.umontpellier.fr/international/venir-etudier-a-la-faculte-de-pharmacie-via-erasmus/>

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Application for full academic year and first semester	From April 1st to June 30th
Application for second semester	From October to 10th December 10th

Application procedure : Nominated students have to send their Erasmus application forms fully filled in and signed by their home university and coordinator to the Administrative coordinator.

Second semester	From the first week of January to May 30th
Holidays	Christmas break : the last 2 weeks of December Easter break : one week in April, last or second to last week in April (depending on the year)

Transcript of records	A Transcript of Records will be issued after the assessment period has finished at our institution.
Language of instruction	French
Language requirement	Minimum recommended : B2 level in French
Language course	Students will be able to take French course for French as a Foreign Language once a week at the Faculty of Pharmacy (2 ECTS) and once a week at the Faculty of Sciences (3 ECTS).
ECTS (European Credit Transfert System)	Students will be awarded ECTS credits when they have passed the assessments corresponding to the courses to which ECTS credits are allocated.
